European Union Declaration of Origin of Materials

In accordance with the restrictions in article 3g (d) of Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 (15 C.F.R. § 758), Phoenix Tube Company hereby acknowledges the receipt of this information by TW Metals LLC (hereinafter "TW Metals") and confirms that our company is compliant with this legislation.

In particular, we understand that it is prohibited, as of Sept 30th, 2023, to directly or indirectly import iron or steel products which have originated from Russia into the European Union (EU) or United Kingdom (UK); and if our company resides in the EU or UK, we understand that it is prohibited to purchase certain products which have originated from Russia. This also includes products which have been processed in a third country incorporating iron and steel products originating in Russia.

Consequently, supplier hereby certifies that all iron and steel products, as listed in Annex XVII of Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 of 31 July 2014 and its subsequent amendments, do not and will not originate from Russia; and will not be incorporated with any iron or steel products as listed in the same Annex XVII originating in Russia when having been processed in a third country. If this status changes, Supplier will provide written documentation if any representations made in this declaration are no longer accurate.

In addition, we confirm that our Material Test Certificates (MTCs) will include a statement of origin for both the melted raw materials and the finished product.
