Re: **Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)**

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) of 1976 provides EPA with authority to require reporting, record-keeping and testing requirements, and restrictions relating to chemical substances and/or mixtures. Certain substances are generally excluded from TSCA, including, among others, food, drugs, cosmetics and pesticides. Some chemicals have specific import and export requirements under section 6 of TSCA. These chemicals include, but aren't limited to PCBs, mercury, and, asbestos. No certification is required for the following:

- Chemicals that are a part of articles, unless required by a specific rule under TSCA
- Tobacco or tobacco products

Phoenix Tube Company produces austenitic stainless-steel tubing and flat bar. Phoenix Tube does not use or add any deemed hazardous substances in our manufacturing process. Phoenix Tube ships stainless steel tubing and flat bar as an "article".

Considering all the above, Phoenix Tube is in compliance with The Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) and needs no certification.
